VERIFY RESIDENCY AND GATHER DOCUMENTATION.

If you currently live in Brookline, gather the required documentation that is needed for the online registration process. View the list of required documents at www.brookline.k12.ma.us/regdocs

REGISTER ONLINE.

During the online registration, you will select a time for your in-person meeting at our Office of Student Affairs.

MEET WITH AN ENROLLMENT TEAM MEMBER AT OUR OFFICE OF STUDENT AFFAIRS AT 24 WEBSTER PLACE.

Our enrollment team will verify your documentation and coordinate your next steps for enrollment.

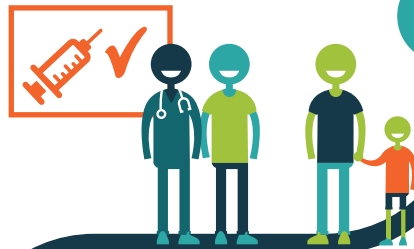
SCHOOL ASSIGNMENT.

The Office of Student Affairs will facilitate all school assignments for families. If you live in a Buffer Zone, you will receive your school assignment on a rolling basis.

MEET WITH YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR AND SCHOOL NURSE.

These two meetings occur at your child's school. At these meetings your child will have the chance to meet their school counselor and school nurse. The school nurse will also verify immunization records.
